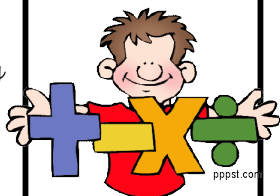


Maths - In maths, year 3 will be looking at fractions and collecting data. They will be continuing with their Big Maths CLIC and SAFE.

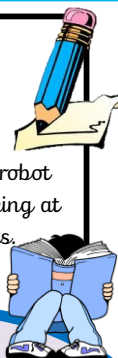
Computing - This term, the children are focusing on their basic skills. This will include using simple programme and keyboard skills.
