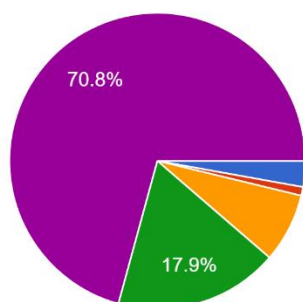

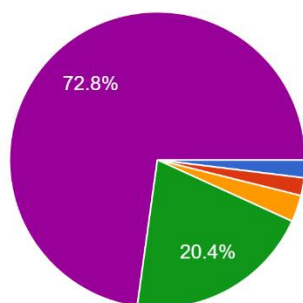

3. I feel that my child is safe at this school

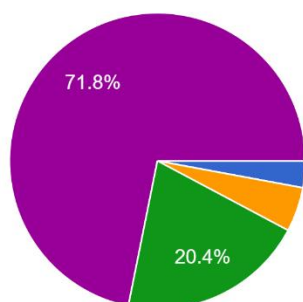

4. Staff treat my child fairly and with respect

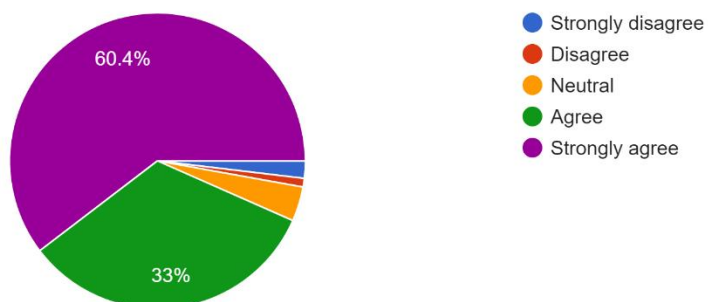

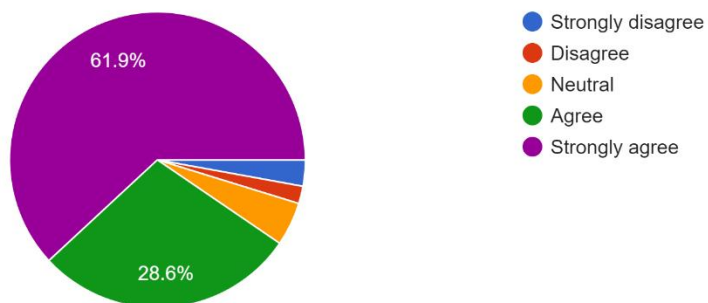
5. I feel staff know my child as an individual

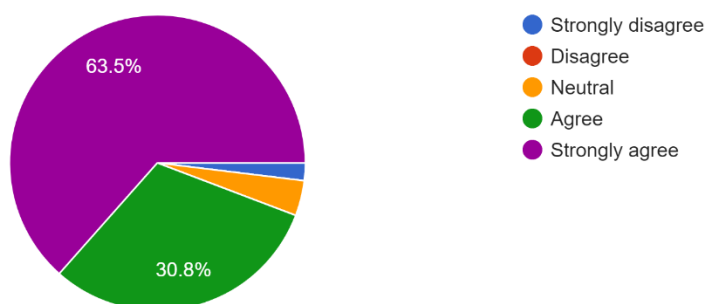
6. My child receives the help he/she needs to do well

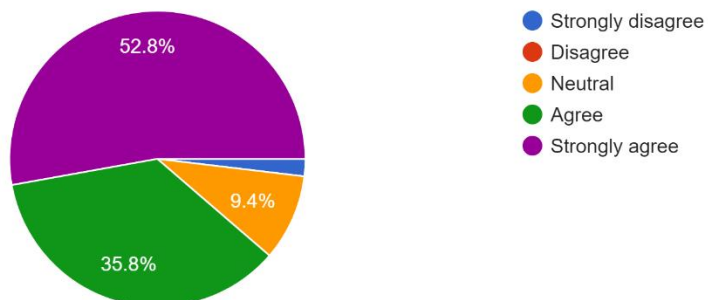
7. My child is encouraged by the school to be healthy and take regular exercise

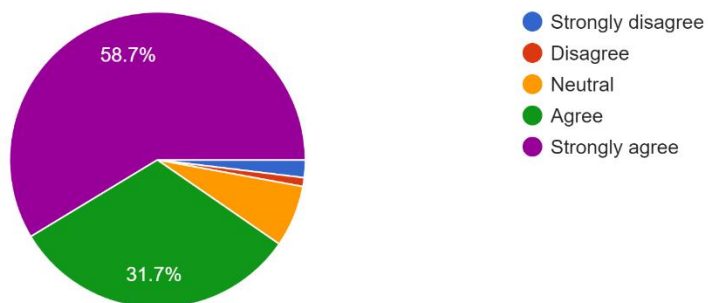
8. The school supports my child's emotional wellbeing

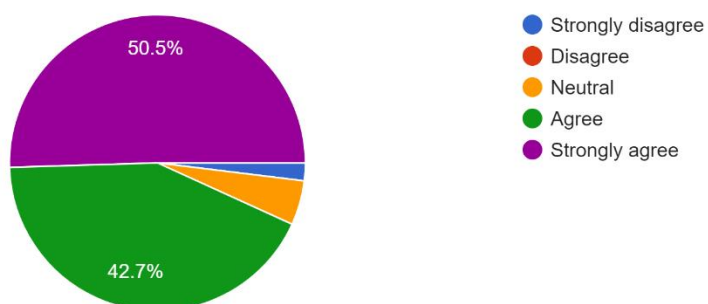
9. My child is making good progress at the school

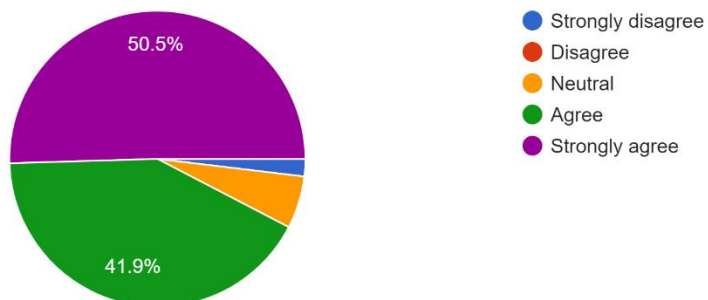
11. I understand how my child's progress is assessed

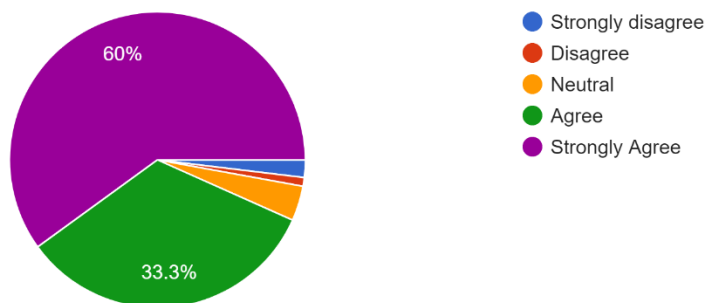
12. The school gives me advice on how to support my child's learning at home

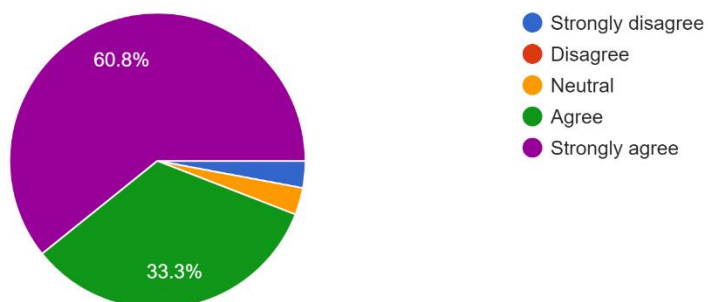
13. I feel comfortable approaching the school with questions, suggestions and/or a problem

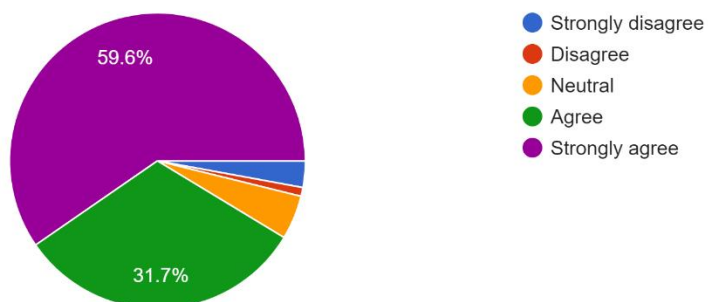
14. I am satisfied with the quality of teaching in the school

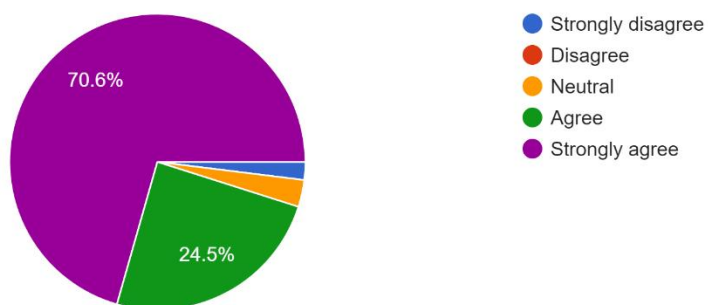

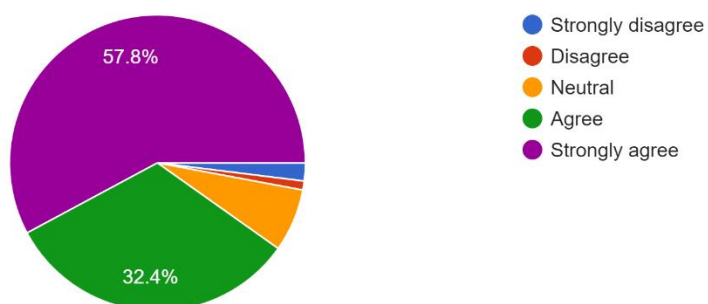
16. The school encourages children to treat others with respect

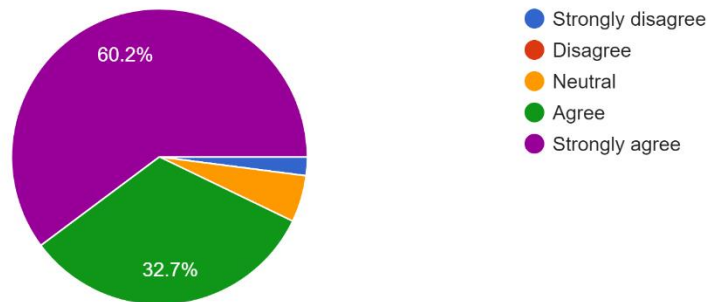
17. I would recommend the school to other parents

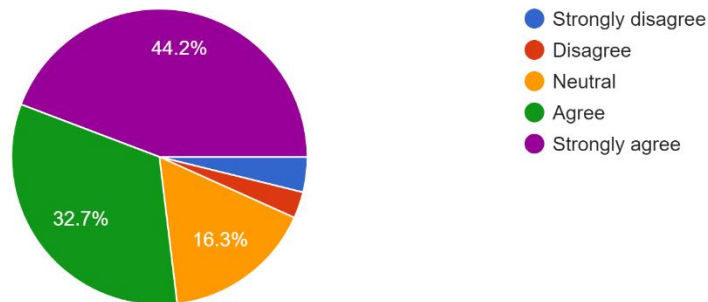
